NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7989) affecting the A1067 Fakenham Road from its junction with A1270 Broadland Northway to its junction with Fir Covert Road in the PARISH OF ATTLEBRIDGE to facilitate stud removal and surface dressing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 23rd May to 14th June 2024 for the duration of the works only whilst signs indicating closures are in place.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
