

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7931) affecting the Reepham Road from its junction with Middlestons Lane to its junction with Brewery Lane in the PARISH OF HELLESDON to facilitate stud removal and surfacing works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 19:00 and 05:00 from 23rd to 28th May 2024 only whilst signs indicating closures are in place.

Alternative route is via: Reepham Road, Middlestons Lane, A140 Holt Road/ Cromer Road, A1270 Broadland Northway, Brewery Lane, Reepham Road (Horsham St. Faith and Newton St. Faith, Hellesdon, Horsford).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

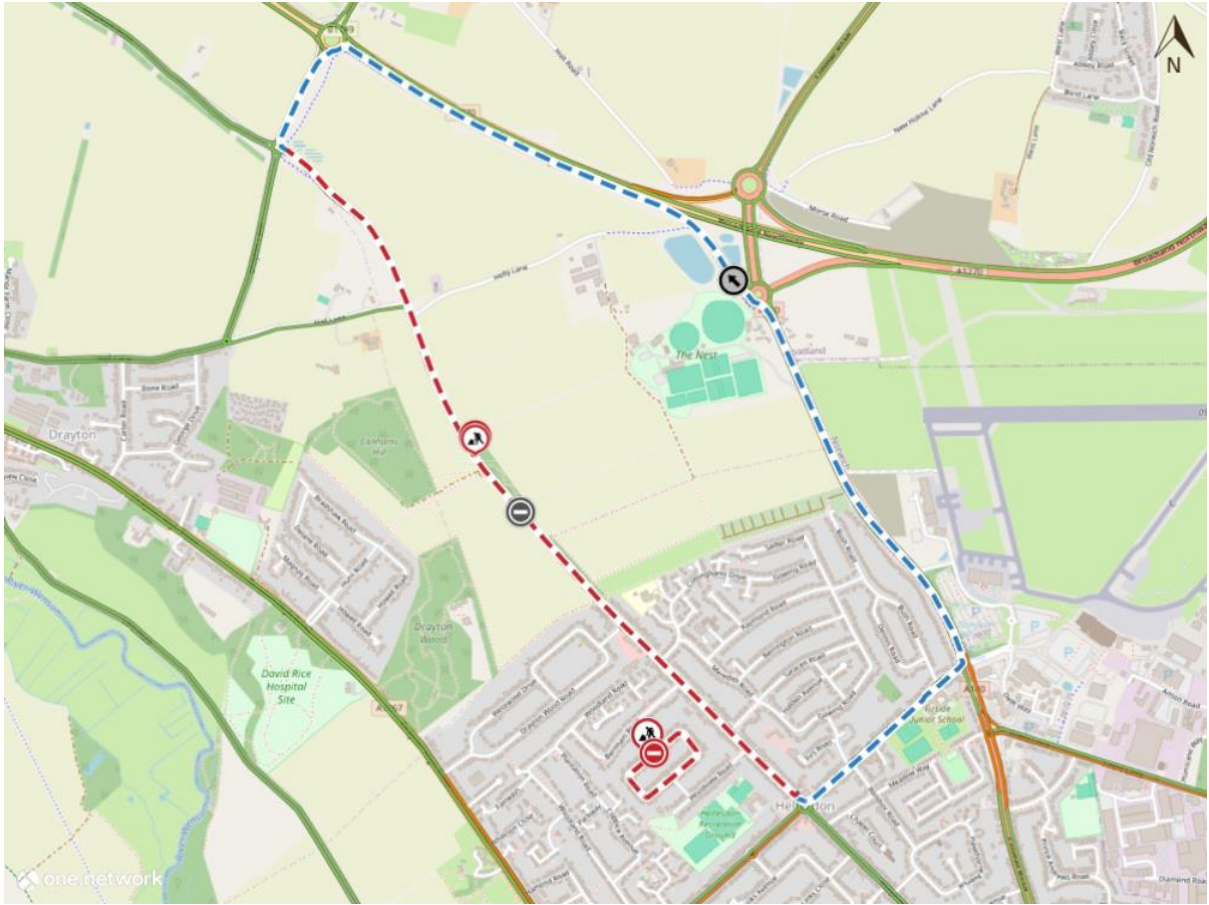
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
